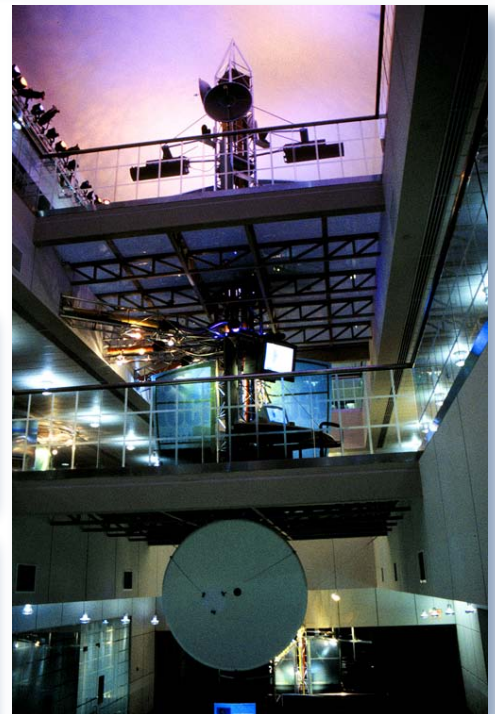

The Center for Interactive Learning at Sinclair Community College in Dayton.

- Futuristic classrooms with multiple layers of lighting controlled by a sophisticated controls system integrated into the global A/V system making for an intuitive user interface.
- The Forum lecture hall is carefully designed to accommodate live presentations, teleconferencing and distance learning.
- The four-story tall “CyberTree” is the central sculptural icon that links numerous interactive exhibits with the environment.
- The vaulted ceiling of the Virtual Skylight bustles with kinetic lighting projections suggesting both theatrically abstracted weather patterns and varying times of day.
