This renovation of the rotunda housing the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States of America required custom LED luminaires to be designed in order to be completely concealed in the historic architectural details, while delivering illumination with a spectrum of light crafted to eliminate damaging UV output while producing the highest quality of color rendering at a custom color temperature.

The control system allows for lighting adjustments to be made over time, to minimize maintenance requirements and triple the typical LED system lifespan.
